



IXTHULUH was psychedelic krautrock from Austria. Started with jazzrock they soon changed in an own direction, called "near sibiria".

Founded 1975 the group was named Ixthuluh since spring 1976. At the beginning enhanced by many bands later collected under the progressive label, the band started early looking for the own sound far-off music business.

The group bought an old farmhouse in 1977 and changed from the band Ixthuluh to the Kollektiv Ixthuluh. Today they would be characterized as jam-band.

Ixthuluh disbanded at the end of 1981.

Totally 5 disks document the work history. The best album ist the 1980 recorded Tea At Two, which appears compact and monolithic and shows best the characteristic sound and the intensity of the band.

This compilation contains tracks from the four regular recordings and two previously unreleased songs, remixed from tapes recorded 1979. This audio document shows the bow of the musical way the band went through the years. Ixthuluh never chumed up to the established flavour but always tryed to find the own sound. The first recordings of "Yes, We Are A Jazzband" the band rehearsed prior jamming the themes. Later they only played, everything is unique. X-Happens ! The material descends from two-track-tape recording machines, which were common audio appliances at this time.
